

A Mercy to Mankind

Our beloved Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم was sent as a **mercy** (rahmah) to mankind. Allah سبحانه وتعالى says in the Qur'an:



"We have sent you (O Prophet) only as a mercy for the whole world." (Surah al-Anbiya: 107)

Rahmah: compassion, care, love, kindness and mercy.

The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم was a *rahmah* to those around him. This means that he was very kind and loving. He cared deeply for everyone and treated people in the best way possible. Not only was he kind to people, he was also very kind to animals, and even trees!

Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم was not only merciful to those around him. He was also very merciful to those people who had not even come into the world yet. He would always worry about his Ummah – me and you. He would spend a long time in sajdah crying and begging Allah to forgive his Ummah.


If we show mercy to others, Allah will show mercy to us!
