We can know and recognise who Allah is by looking at all the signs around us. But did you know that there are so many **signs** inside our own bodies?

Allah سبحانه وتعالى says:

Allah Created Us in the Best Form

Allah tells us that He has created our bodies in the best of forms.



Indeed, We created humans in the best form.

(Surah at-Tin: 4)

This means that Allah made us all beautiful and we should respect our bodies.

Allah has created the human body in all shapes and sizes.



The Human Body Is Amazing!

Look at this diagram showing the inside of your body:

Allah created a skeleton to support your body and protect everything that is inside you. Allah gifted you with a **brain** which allows you to think and control your movements.

Allah created you with a **heart** that pumps blood around your body, bringing oxygen to every part.

Allah gave you **lungs** for breathing and bringing oxygen into your blood.



Our body is a gift from Allah and a sign of His power to create.

Allah provided you with a **liver** and two **kidneys** that clean your blood as it flows around your body.
