The Most Beloved Places to Allah

The masjid is the house of Allah. Allah سبحانه وتعالى loves the masjid because it is a place where He is remembered.

The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم said:





"The most beloved places to Allah are the masajid." (Muslim)

'Masajid' is the plural of masjid.

The first thing the Prophet من الله عليه وسلم did when he migrated from Makkah to Madinah was build a masjid. For him, this was the most important thing. He started building a masjid even before his own home.

The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم loved the masjid and so did all his Companions . He would use the masjid to lead salah, teach others about Islam,

help the poor and needy, and do everything that would help Islam and the Muslims. **The** masiid was like a home for them.

I love the masjid!





The Etiquettes of the Masjid

Our beloved Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم taught us how we should behave in a masjid. Here are some of the etiquettes:

- Dress appropriately.
- Ensure your mouth does not smell of something strong you have eaten e.g. onions.
- Enter with the right foot and say the du'a.
- 🐈 Leave with the left foot and say the du'a.
- ray two rak ahs when entering (also known as tahiyyatul-masjid).
- Do not talk about worldly matters.
- Remain silent in the masjid.
- Spend your time reciting Qur'an, praying salah and doing dhikr.
- Reply to the adhan.
