The Weeping Tree

Every week there is a special day: the Day of Jumuʿah. On this day, the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم would lean on the trunk of a palm tree and would deliver the khutbah (special sermon) to all the Companions.

One day, an Ansari Companion asked the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم: "Shall we make you a **minbar** (pulpit)?" He agreed and so they decided to build a minbar for the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم so that he could give the khutbah more comfortably.

The day had arrived. It was time to deliver the sermon on the new minbar. The room was quiet. Everyone was eager to listen to the beautiful words of the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم. Suddenly, they could hear sounds which sounded like a crying baby. Everyone's heads

turned to see where the noise was coming from. It was the tree which the Prophet used to lean on. The Companions were astounded and waited to see the reaction of the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم.

The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم climbed down the minbar and went to the tree. He softly stroked it and gave it a hug to comfort it. To everyone's surprise, the tree immediately stopped crying.
