

Today, the Ummah of Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم is spread all over the world.






I am a Mu'min and I love my

"All believers are but brothers..." (49:10)

The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم told us that **we should live as brothers:** we should not be jealous of each other, we should not hate each other, and we should not hurt each other. We should always help each other and not abandon our brothers in times of need. The believers are like one body: if one part feels pain, the rest of the body also feels pain. This means that if a Muslim in China is in pain, a Muslim in Ghana should feel their pain and do their best to help them.
