Allah Is ar-Raqib

Allah سبحانه وتعالى says in the Qur'an:



وَكَانَ ٱللَّهُ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ رَّقِيْبًا

"And Allah is **Ever Watchful** over all things." (Surah al-Ahzab:52)

Allah is ar-Raqib: the Ever-Watchful. This means that He watches over all of His servants. Allah watches over all matters — the hidden and the apparent. Allah oversees everything, whether we are alone or with other people. Allah even knows our intentions and the state of our hearts!

Sometimes we may think we can do bad things in secret and no one will find out, but we should always remember that Allah is ar-Raqib: He is always watching and **monitoring** us.




2 Another meaning of ar-Raqib is that Allah watches over us and cares for us. Knowing this should bring us comfort and peace.

There is nowhere on earth where you can hide from Allah!






How Can I Worship Allah ar-Raqib?

We can worship Allah, ar-Raqib, through muragabah: being constantly aware of His presence. This awareness makes us mindful of what we think, say, and do. It makes us guard our tongues and even our intentions. It makes us feel ashamed to commit sins.



Muragabah:

You are always aware that Allah is watching you, so you take care of your **heart** and your actions.


