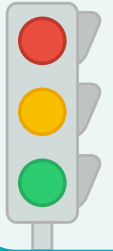

## The Ka'bah and a Message to the Disbelievers

- ★ Surah al-Fil teaches us how important the Ka'bah is. It is the sacred and blessed House of Allah. **Allah protected it** from people who tried to harm it.
- ★ Allah reminds the disbelievers of Makkah that this was a **special favour from Him**, and they should have thanked Him by worshipping Him alone.
- ★ The disbelievers should **not be arrogant** about their strength or numbers. Allah destroyed people who were more powerful than them!
- ★ Abrahah is dead, but the **Ka'bah remains**—honoured and loved by millions across the world who face it in every salah and dream of visiting it.



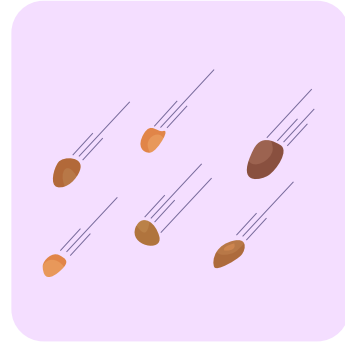
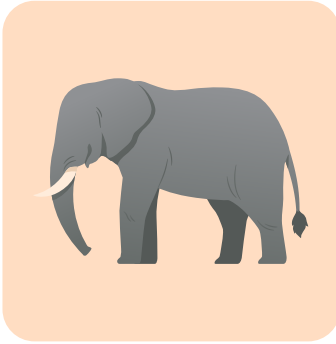
## Did You Know?

## Truth vs. Falsehood

I strengthen my ummah.



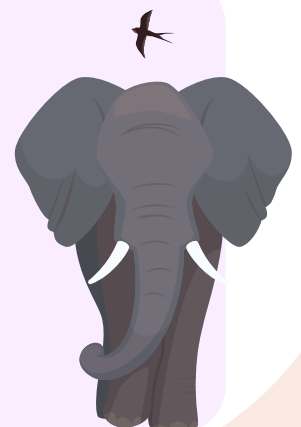

## The Power of Allah

- ★ There is nothing and **no one more powerful than Allah!** No army, empire, country, king or president is greater than Allah. That's why only Allah deserves to be worshipped.
- ★ Allah destroyed the people of the elephant using some of **His weakest creations**—small animals that normally do not harm humans.

## Comfort and Strength

- ★ This surah shows how much Allah **loved** and supported Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم. It's like Allah is saying that if He protected His House, He will surely protect His most beloved servant, Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم.
- ★ It also strengthens the weak Muslims who are going through difficult times. It **comforts** them that Allah will protect them and He is the All-Powerful.
