



## Adab & Akhlaq

#### **Aims of Adab & Akhlaq Lessons**

- To love the Prophet 🏶 and his sunnah, and memorise his sayings
- 2 To emulate his perfect example, including his character and worship
- To fulfil the rights of Allah's creation, and to constantly strive for exemplary akhlāq
- To feel honour in the values of our dīn and recognise their universality and superiority
- To develop personal strength and live a holistically healthy lifestyle
- To remember and ask Allah as the Prophet 🏶 did
- To deeply connect to Allah, by memorising the adhkār and reflecting on their meanings and virtues

Indeed, Allah bestowed a favour on the believers when He raised in their midst" a Messenger from among themselves — who recites to them His verses, **purifies them**, and teaches them the Book and **wisdom**. For indeed, they had previously (been clearly astray." (3:164

One of the overarching goals of the mission of the Prophet was to **purify souls** and refine character. He said: "I was sent to perfect good character" (Aḥmad). Akhlāq (character) and ādāb (etiquettes) are not 'extras' or 'niceties' — rather they are fundamental aspects of the dīn, and determine a person's eternal destiny.

#### **The Best Example**

The Prophet had the best character. The greatest testimony of his character comes from the Lord of the heavens and the earth Himself:

"And you are truly (a man) of outstanding character." (68:4)

The goal of Qurānic Tarbiyah is to nurture children to 'live' the Qur'ān. The Prophet did not merely teach his companions how to recite the Qur'ān beautifully.

Rather, 'his character was the Qur'ān' and he nurtured exemplary character in his Companions, young and old.

Thus, it is vital that alongside teaching our children to recite the Qur'ān, we teach them how to embody its teachings, and we instil in them excellent akhlāq. One of the most powerful means of achieving this is by **learning and reflecting on the Prophetic example.** Doing this will also increase our love and īmān in him ...

Children should be inspired to adopt the Prophet as their role model, and to follow his Sunnah in every aspect of their lives. This includes how he ate, drank, interacted with others, prayed, remembered Allah, and worked hard to establish Allah's dīn.

#### **Contemporary Challenges**

Today, morality is seen as being relative. Value and morals are constantly shifting, causing havoc to our collective well-being.

In the midst of our confusion, we look around for solutions to our problems, but fail to realise that the best value system is the Divine system sent to the Prophet ...

Children have an exceptional capacity to absorb information and learn from their surroundings, be it the home, school and especially via the screen. Often, the values they are exposed to are immoral, ego-centric and have led to the disintegration of families and communities. It is vital that we proactively counteract these influences, and instead fill the hearts and minds of our young ones with the love of Allah and the **Prophetic way of 'being'.** 

Our children must be anchored by divine guidance. They should be guided by the Qur'ān and Sunnah, and feel immensely fortunate that they have been gifted the best moral compass.

#### **Learning by Example**

As educators, we should constantly engage in the purification (tazkiyah) of our souls and always strive to improve our own character. Children learn by example, and it is vital that they do not see a discrepancy between our own character and what we 'teach' them about Prophetic character.

#### **Good Company**

By being in the company (ṣuḥbah) of the Prophet , his Companions absorbed the best way of being. They learned and adopted his lofty characteristics and they were purified from negative traits. Upright character is learnt through the company we keep, and as educators, we should try to foster an environment which facilitates this.

#### **Iman & Adab with Allah**

Children should be motivated to practise good character as an important means to seeking the pleasure and love of Allah .

The scholars have mentioned that the first step to changing behaviour is to activate  $\bar{m}$ an. If we focus merely on outward poor behaviour, this may leave a negative impact on the heart. Instead we should focus on  $\bar{m}$ an so that children can learn to love what Allah loves, and hate what Allah hates. This does not mean that we should not correct unwanted behaviours — but rather we should do so with sensitivity and kindness.

Along with learning how to treat and honour Allah's creation in the best way, children should be taught about having 'adab' with Allah. This is more important in our times where secularism, atheism and materialism being propagated globally in an aggressive manner.

#### **United Ummah**

Character building requires time and patience. Tarbiyah is a long and gradual process. A character trait or behaviour must be rehearsed for some time before it becomes an intrinsic quality. Educators are encouraged to give children ample opportunities where they can practise these lofty qualities. In addition to this, educators are encouraged to create a space where children truly experience the value of an environment that upholds the Sunnah: a place where they are cherished, valued and nurtured.

We ask Allah to guide us to the best character, as He is the Only One who can do this. We ask Him to make us vehicles of true transformation in the Ummah. May we treat our children with love, kindness and gentleness, so that they can become powerful building blocks of a united Ummah.

This book may also be used in a home setting. Although every child is different, the average target age of this book is 5 and above. Whilst older children may learn from and use this book independently, younger children may require assistance from an adult.

In order to nurture Prophetic akhlāq in our children, we have to embody these akhlāq ourselves, especially when we are teaching. Muʿāwiyah b. al-Ḥakam said about the Prophet "...May my father and mother be ransomed for him! I have not seen a teacher before him nor after him who was better than him in teaching. By Allah, he did not scold me, nor did he hit me or insult me..." (Bukhārī).

We look forward to hearing your feedback and suggested changes which can be incorporated in the next edition inshāAllah.

We pray our young learners grow to exemplify Prophetic character in all aspects of their lives, and enrich their communities and the entire world.

Allah loved this so much that He revealed a verse of the Qur'an, praising Abu Talhah and his wife!





# Saying Salam to everyone





A Muslim is active and not lazy.

A Muslim tries to be the first one to do good.

Let us look at some examples of how the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم and Sahabah were active and the first to do good.

#### The Sudden Noise

One night, the people of Madinah suddenly woke up because of a sound they heard. They all came out of their homes to check if it was an enemy trying to attack. They suddenly saw the Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم on a horse telling them not to be scared. The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم had already rode around Madinah and checked if there was an enemy.

## Buying a Well for the Muslims

When the Muslims came to Madinah, there was only one well which had clean and sweet water. But it was very expensive for the Muslims to drink from it. The Prophet صلى الله عليه وسلم promised a spring in Jannah for whoever bought the well allowing the Muslims to drink from it without having to pay. Uthman رضي الله عنه , saw this as a chance to do good, so he quickly bought the expensive well.



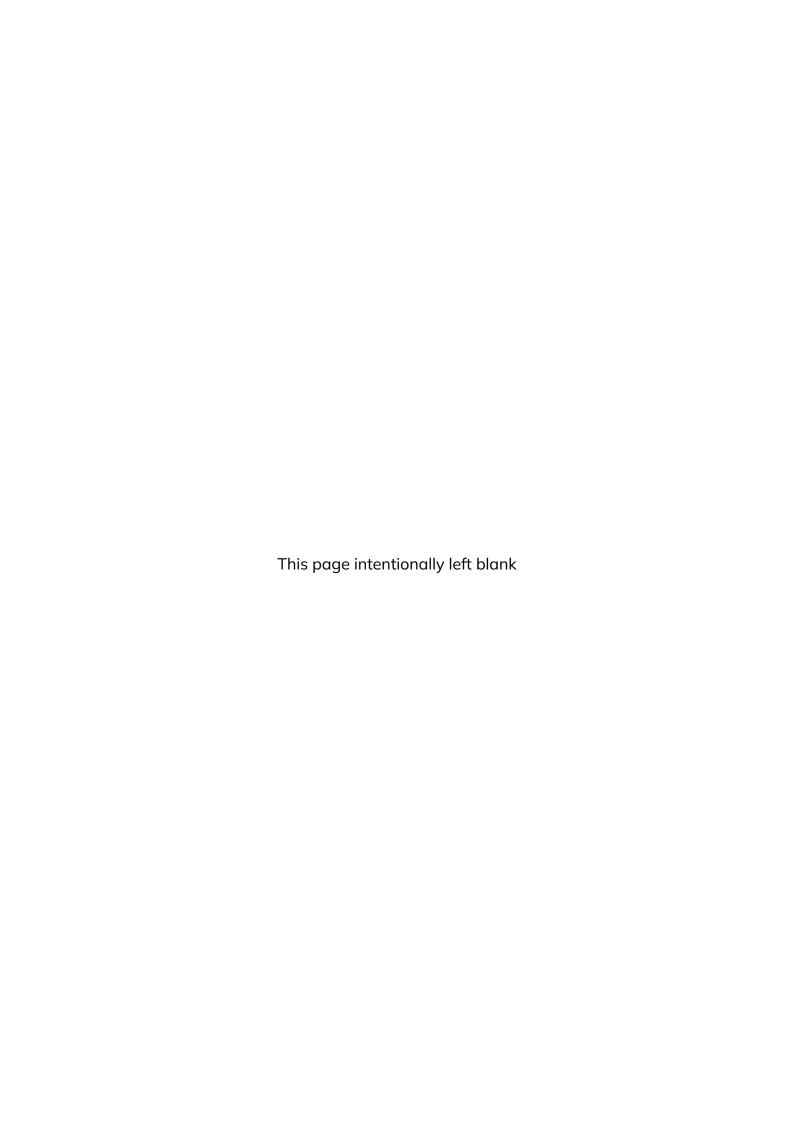
